Re: First Contact in event of Emergency
Other pertinent reminders

In the case of almost all EMERGENCIES – medical problems, fires, smoke, suspected criminal activity, resident down who needs assistance to get up – residents **FIRST** phone call should be to **911 EMERGENCY SERVICES**. The Hershey's Mill Security will be alerted about the dispatch of the fire department or an ambulance, however if a resident has the time and capability after calling 911, they can then contact Security at the Main Gate (**610 436-6403**) to alert them as well.

Calling Security first just delays the final necessary call to 911 and slows the response you are seeking.

Other good reminders:

1. Please do not raise the Security Gate for cars, trucks, vendors in front of you that do not have gate opening devices. They should be directed to the Main Gate. There are Turn Arounds at the Main, North and West (Rite Aid Parking lot) Gates. The East Gate has several signs advising ALL that it is for Residents Only and contractors should proceed to Main Gate on Green Hill Road.
2. Please observe/obey all posted Speed Limits and STOP signs. They are for your safety.
3. When walking, utilize sidewalks, paths and trails where provided rather than walking in the street.
4. Lock your car doors and home doors – this is just common sense wherever you may be.
